

CHILDREN'S BIRD COUNT

In 2019 we had the first approach with children. We gave them a speech about birds, and how to identify them. That day we took a short walk through our community's park to teach children how to count birds.

In December 2020 we carried out the first child bird count with the participation of 15 children from Caño Negro, Upala, Sarapiquí and San Carlos. We managed to count 33 species of birds. The bird count of Caño Negro is done once a year in the month of December with the aim of obtaining valuable information on the bird species that visit the refuge. 2020 was our first year as partners in this great program.
